**PPE DESCRIPTION:**

Five-fingered glove, comprising different pieces sewn together to form the palm, back and wrist. The palm is formed from two pieces of dark grey grained leather and the finger tips (except the little finger) are reinforced in the same leather. The back is formed from two pieces; one in dark grey grained leather covering the thumb and a piece of light grey split leather covering the rest of the back. The wrist is formed from a double woven, black elasticated material joined by a horizontal seam to the palm and the back. Near the palm is a semi-circular tongue covering part of the wrist. The interior is lined with black brushed material and the interior seam joining the palm and the back bears an identification label.

The materials that form the PPE, are described in the test report No. 2013EP1676.
